Baby Bottle Kids Campaign!

Kids Can Make a Difference!

The Baby Bottle Kids' Campaign provides an opportunity to teach children the value of life. Also, by filling their bottles with loose change, kids become engaged in a practical, hands-on way to serve those in need.

Tips for Talking with Children:

- 1 Focus on the value of life.
- 2 Teach about the dignity of worth of every human person, even those smaller than them.
- 3 Emphasize how filling their baby bottle can provide resources and materials for families in need.
- 4 Get the whole family involved by talking at home about how life is sacred. Read Jeremiah 1:5 and Psalm 139:14.

Two Fun-Sized Kids' Lessons:

ACTIVITY: Read *Audrey Bunny* by Angie Smith to teach that everyone is special and wonderfully made by God. (Summary: A stuffed animal named Audrey Bunny fears her imperfections make her unworthy of a little girl's love, only to find out that these imperfections are what makes her unique, special, and in fact, loved by her owner.)

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Why does Audrey Bunny think that she won't be loved by Caroline and others?
2. How does Caroline show Audrey Bunny that she loves her?

TAKE-AWAY POINTS

- God makes each one of us special just like Audrey Bunny's spot over her heart made her special.
- We are all wonderfully made by God. God knit us together in our mother's womb (Psalm 139:13). He knows everything about us even before we were born...what color our eyes will be, how tall we will be...even the exact number of hairs on our head.

ACTIVITY: Show a picture or model of a 20 week old fetus. Point out its size and different characteristics like its nose, eyes and feet.

Then, ask for a volunteer (or a few) to demonstrate a somersault in front of the group. Have other kids cheer for the volunteer. Explain to kids that when you were only 20 weeks old (the same size of the fetus picture or model) you had already started doing somersaults inside of your mommy's tummy!

TAKE-AWAY POINTS

- In the Bible, we read that God knew each one of us, even before we were born (Jer 1:5). He already knew what color our eyes would be and he already knew whether or not we would be able to do somersaults or not!
- Those smaller than us are very, very important to God. He created you and me in a unique way and Jesus teaches us to love others, no matter how big or little we are!
