Sample Bulletin Announcements:

Here are some sample announcements you can use during and after the Baby Bottle Campaign in church bulletins or email listservs. Feel free to modify them as needed if space is an issue.

- **Week 1 Announcement:**

The Baby Bottle Campaign starts today! The campaign makes it easy for you to participate in the ministry of the Pregnancy Resource Center of the New River Valley. Just pick up a bottle as you leave today and fill it with coins and cash or checks payable to the Pregnancy Resource Center of the NRV, then bring it back to church in two weeks.

- **Week 2 Announcement:**

Remember that baby bottle you picked up last week? Keep filling it with coins, cash or checks payable to the Pregnancy Resource Center of the NRV. Don't forget to bring all bottles back to church with you next week so we can return them to the PRC!

- **Week 3 Announcement:**

Did you bring your baby bottle back? The Baby Bottle Campaign for the Pregnancy Resource Center ends today, and we're collecting the bottles to return them to the PRC. If you forgot to bring your bottle today, you can bring it to church next Sunday or drop it off at either of the PRC's clinics, Valley Women's Clinic, in Blacksburg or Radford.

- **Week 4 Announcement:**

Do you still have your baby bottle? The Pregnancy Resource Center is now counting all the change we raised to help women and men in our community facing unplanned pregnancies. Bring your bottle back to church or drop it off at the PRC so your change can be a part of that too! If you haven't had a chance to fill your bottle, please return it anyway so it can be used again next year.
