

Katelyn wasn't sure she could keep this new child and was considering adoption. While on Facebook one evening, she happened to see a response about the Valley Women's Clinic support on someone else's comment. Searching for her own answers, she connected with our clinic to see if we could help her too.

"I've not only gained knowledge through watching parenting videos, I've also had the opportunity to earn free diapers and supplies by doing so. No matter how much I feel like I messed up in my decision making, when I look into my daughter's eyes, I know I made the right choice in keeping her! I wouldn't have believed that before, if not for the guidance of the Valley Women's Clinic. I now have two beautiful children and a support system through a local church. My plans are to go back to school in the fall and create a good life for my kids! I'm thankful for the PRC and all of the support they have given me through the Valley Women's Clinic; I was able to keep my daughter through their support." Last year <u>350</u> of you volunteered over <u>3,900 hours</u> to make this ministry happen! This included mission projects, fundraising, event support, teachers in our education program, weekly counselors, nurses, landscaping, and tech support. Other volunteers are pastors and advocates who keep engaged with PRC as a mission outreach for their church. We're blessed to have such an ongoing outpouring of faithful servants!

Through Giving

There are so many ways our supporters come together that evidences God's blessing on this ministry:

- Our LifeSponsors, our committed monthly givers, substantiate much of our budget. The number of these suporters have more than doubled since 2014.
- We have three annual fundraising events, highlighted in this issue: Baby Bottles, Walk for Life and Annual Benefit Banquet
- Other ways community members come alongside us throughout the year include diaper drives, baby showers, one-time donations, community/ church benefits naming us as recipients, transfers of stock or retirement funds, memorial or honorarium gifts, or large gifts like cars or vehicles. VOLUNTEER Spotlight: DEBBIE WILLIAMS

Debbie has been the longest serving volunteer with the PRC, 14 of our 33 years! She first came to PRC after Linda Robinson, former PRC Director, spoke at her church and asked for volunteers. Debbie had older boys in high school at the time and it was a place she felt she could give back.

Debbie shared, "PRC was in Christiansburg at the time, so I decided to volunteer on Thursdays", a post she has kept over the many years and changes of the PRC. "Then our center moved to Blacksburg, added a mobile unit that went to Radford, and now have a second center in Radford." Debbie also has seen the staff, volunteers, fundraisers and the supporters grow. Debbie shared that she has grown through her experiences serving with the PRC, "When I began, I felt inadequate. But over the various in-service trainings and by meeting the women, I realized what a wonderful place to just be a voice for the Lord. We share in different ways, but it's a step out on faith for me. It's a great ministry right here in the NRV. You don't have to go to as far as Africa to find people in need of our help. This is a great ministry to support, to volunteer, and get involved in." We've had various paid job openings over the years and have talked to Debbie about her interest and she always replies, "No, this is what I do to serve God. I'll keep volunteering."


