What an honor to be part of a ministry where we see a young woman move from her fears to her Provision! Meet Maria*, a client, who tells her story in her own words:

"I moved from my home country to Blacksburg with great expectations of my new life as a student at Virginia Tech. I was feeling free, confident and full of energy as I reached out to this new life ahead of me to expand my skills and career.

Then I found out I was pregnant. I had already ended the relationship with my boyfriend and having a baby was not part of my plans. Suddenly now I saw myself as alone and desperate, far from home, weak, vulnerable and scared. How could I be a student and a single mother? For the first time I felt no power in my own life. I felt trapped.

I came to associate the Valley Women's Clinic as a touch of God's hand to me.

I saw the sign for Valley Women's Clinic (VWC) and came inside. To my relief, they became an instant source of support, coming alongside me, welcoming me in a loving way. They embraced me in my circumstances and offered a free ultrasound. Seeing my baby at that ultrasound allowed me to feel the joy of being a mother for the very first time! I saw things more clearly then. I realized I was being blessed with this gift of life and a new baby was coming to bring me happiness.

My advisors at Virginia Tech and even my family back home were supportive. And I had VWC as my resource. I took the weekly one-on-one classes to learn about my pregnancy found them to be helpful, relaxing and exciting. As my counselor prayed with me I felt peaceful and comforted, knowing God was taking care of me. I'm so grateful I found this place! I am now confident and happy. I came to associate the VWC as a touch of God's hand to me ---as a way He chose to show me that He was providing."

Volunteer & LifeSponsor Testimony: Dr. Michael Slayton

Dr. Slayton had attended several PRC banquets, when one particular year a question on our response sheet, "Could you see yourself involved in any way in this ministry?" caught his attention. He decided he'd check "Yes" even though he didn't know what that would mean. It wasn't long before a call came and he discovered that it was a critical time in the life of the PRC. It was 1999, we were transitioning to become not only a pregnancy options counseling center, but also a medical center, in order to add ultrasounds to our services. As a physician, his help was definitely needed! "Going medical was one of the most exciting, rewarding times for PRC ministry, pivotal in providing women with knowledge of what was happening in the womb, allowing them to see a real, living human being and make an informed decision. It (ultrasound) has been instrumental in changing hearts and minds since." "As a physician", Dr. Slayton shared, "I value human life—it is sacred and valuable. Whether it is the experienced life of one of my geriatric patients, or the birth of one of my grandchildren, it can bring me to tears---there is beauty in that. All I have learned has taught me to appreciate life. I fully believe in the PRC purpose and mission." Dr. Slayton served as our PRC medical director from 1999 through 2010. He continues to volunteer as a banquet table host and an enthusiastic prayer partner for this ministry along with his wife, Marnie.
